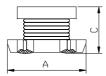

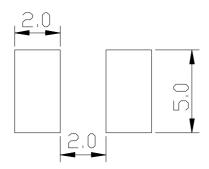

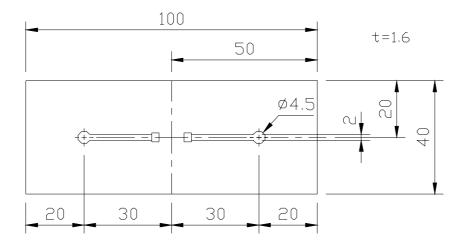
### (5)-1 LAND PATTERN DIMENSIONS

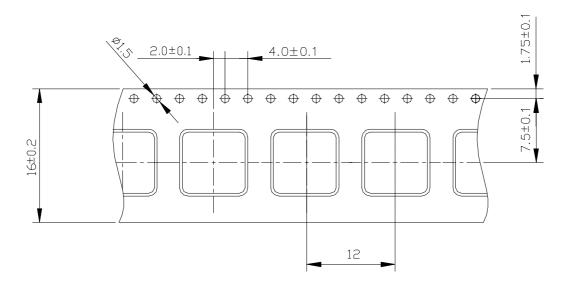


### (5)-2 SUBSTRATE BENDING TEST BENDING TEST BOARD

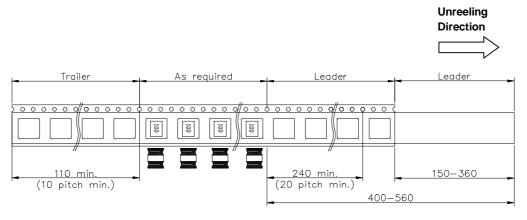

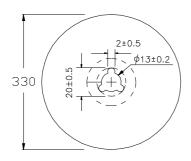
### (6)-1 CARRIER TAPE DIMENSIONS (mm)

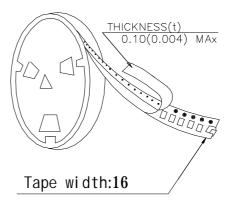


### (6)-2 TAPING DIMENSIONS (mm)
